Commonly Used Abbreviations and Terms

10-Year MOC 10-Year Maintenance of Certification Program applies to diplomates issued a 10-year

time-limited certificate between 1994-2011 (primary specialties). This program will

sunset in 2021.

ADA Americans with Disabilities Act.

Applicant A physician who has applied for but has not yet been approved to sit for an ABPN

examination.

C-MOC The Continuous Maintenance of Certification program applies to diplomates certified

or recertified from 2012 to the present.

CME Continuing Medical Education, which is educational activities that serve to maintain,

develop, or increase the knowledge, skills, and professional performance and

relationships that a physician uses to provide services for patients, the public, or the profession. CME is one of the four MOC components mandated by the ABMS for ABPN

maintenance of certification.

CSE Clinical Skills Evaluation.

Candidate An applicant who has been approved to sit for an ABPN examination.

DSM-5 Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, Fifth Edition.

Diplomate A physician who has passed an ABPN exam and who is currently board certified by the

ABPN.

Folios Refers to the ABPN Physician Folios account, which is used by candidates and

diplomates for applying and paying for an exam, managing personal information and

updating and tracking MOC requirements.

IFA Information for Applicants booklets, which are unique documents with background

information about each specialty, subspecialty or combined initial certification or

MOC examination that the ABPN administers.

MOC Maintenance of Certification

PIP Improvement in Medical Practice (PIP). PIP is one of the MOC components mandated

by the ABMS for maintenance of certification.

PreCERT® Refers to the ABPN PreCERT® Credentialing System, used by training directors and

coordinators to input and update resident training information.

SA Self-Assessment. Self-Assessment is one of the MOC components mandated by the

ABMS for ABPN maintenance of certification.

verifyCERT® Refers to the ABPN verifyCERT® Certification and Status Verification System, used by

credentialers and the public to identify physicians who have been certified by the

ABPN and to view the status of their certificates.
